
Step-by-step instructions





## Log in

The administrator of your PetLink Animal Professional account can create a username and password for you.






Enter the microchip number of the pet you have found.






#### You can do this in one of three ways

Type the number in






Press and hold the microphone symbol

Press the 'by camera' icon and use your phone's camera to recognize a number on a microchip reader screen



Hit Search and PetLink Pro will search for owner details first in PetLink, then in PetLink's Backtrack system and finally in the AAHA Pet microchip look up tool.


























At this point you can submit a Found pet report to PetLink so that we can notify the owner via email, phone and SMS that their pet has been found.








#### **Result 1**

Likewise if you press the email button you can use your phone to email the owner directly.




## Microchip number not found in PetLink but found in the PetLink Backtrack database.

The backtrack database is a record of which Vet Hospital, Shelter, or other organization purchased the microchip from Datamars. The Vet Hospital may have a record of the pet and owner contact details for a microchip, even if that microchip has not been registered in PetLink.






You can press the phone button to contact the organization that bought the microchip and ask if they have records for an owner.





#### **Result 3**


The microchip number is not found in either PetLink or Backtrack. The app will then search the AAHA Universal Pet Microchip Lookup tool.


You can press the blue button to find the results on the AAHA **petmicrochiplookup.org** tool.
